Officer is Thankful for Donation And New Police K-9

An organization whose sole purpose is to show appreciation to officers during times of loss has contributed to the Arlington Police Foundation.

With a \$12,000 donation from Tarrant County Blue, K-9 Handler Vince Ramsour is training a new partner.

He has named him Dude.

Dude replaces K-9 Mojo who died in July 2016 after an exhaustive search for an aggravated assault suspect. Like Mojo, the new K-9 is a Belgian Malinois. He is approximately 18 months old.

Tarrant County Blue is made up of more than 40 board members. There are no meetings. When an officer falls in the

line of duty, each board member donates \$100 to the family.

When a member sees an officer in public, they anonymously pay for the police officer's meal, haircut, movie or service, always accompanied by the message, "We appreciate what you do in our community."
